Abstract

Jeanne Siegel was the influential chair of SVA's BFA Fine Arts Department from 1976-2005. A writer, essayist, art critic, curator, and educator, she left a profound mark on a generation of artists who studied at SVA. She organized and moderated countless panel discussions on contemporary art issues, curated exhibitions, edited and contributed to numerous art journals, and was the author of Artwords: Discourse on the 6os and 7os, Artwords 2: Discourse on the Early 8os, and Painting After Pollock: Structures of Influence. Siegel passed away in 2013.
